In charge of purchasing industrial services, the buyer is responsible for ensuring that the purchasing process by controlling the Safety, Quality, Cost and Deadline :

- Analysing the scope of expenditure and identifying potential savings,
- Searching for and qualifying suppliers capable of meeting the needs set out in the specifications,
- Drawing up and managing spot consultations or invitations to tender in project mode with internal customers,
- Make recommendations,
- Negotiate and draft contracts in conjunction with the Legal Department,
- Organising and leading contract reviews with internal customers and the improvement support team,
- Monitor contracts and provide support to operations to resolve disputes, anticipate and find solutions to problems,
- Be a driving force behind proposals to improve plant processes.

Responsibilities:

- Establishing the purchasing strategy for its commodities,
- Build up a supplier panel to ensure that services are provided correctly,
- Negotiate the best terms (Safety, Quality, Deadlines, Costs) for industrial services,
- Measure the performance of service providers and define action plans to ensure improvement,
- To be responsible for supplier assessments of the panel in line with the Purchasing process
- Monitor non-conformities and disputes.
