You have vocational training in maintenance (CAP, BEP, BAC PRO) and significant experience in electrical maintenance. You will have considerable experience in industrial electrical maintenance and sound knowledge of general electricity (reading diagrams, understanding components, troubleshooting and diagnostics).



Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, the Electrical Maintenance Operator is responsible for the electrical maintenance of the plant's equipment.

Main tasks:

- He/she is responsible for carrying out preventive and corrective electrical maintenance.
- Participates in diagnostics and troubleshooting
- Carries out electrical maintenance work in compliance with Health, Safety and Security rules and fundamentals
- Carry out safety rounds in the workshop (interactions, STOP 5, CCC, safety declarations, CRM)
