

## Mechanical maintenance operator



You have vocational training in maintenance (CAP/BEP/BAC) and significant experience in mechanical maintenance.

You will have considerable experience in general mechanics (assembly, dismantling, adjustment of components/bearings/couplings, dimensioning, lubrication, hydraulics, etc.) and be operational in general work (removal/installation of equipment such as fans/motors/boosters, lining, welding of supports, rollers, minor welding, etc.).



Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, the Maintenance Operator is responsible for the mechanical maintenance of the plant's equipment.

Main tasks:

- He/she is responsible for carrying out preventive and corrective mechanical maintenance operations.
- Participates in diagnostics and troubleshooting
- Carries out maintenance work in compliance with Health, Safety and Security rules and fundamentals
- Carry out safety rounds in the workshop (interactions, STOP 5, CCC, safety declarations, CRM).
